

A Typical Day at LLPS

Arrival/Centers - Upon arrival, children choose from a wide variety of centers to play in, such as:

- Bikes
- Puzzles
- Painting
- Play-doh
- Books
- Legos
- Blocks
- Dress-up
- Imaginative Play

Jesus Time gives pastors and teachers time to teach interactive Bible stories, fun “Jesus Songs” and prayers.

Class Time separates children into their own classrooms to study their letter of the week and other skills such as writing, number and letter recognition, counting, sorting and patterns. Classes begin with weather, time for sharing, stories, songs and finger plays.

Play Time (gross motor skills) gives children the chance to play outside or in the gym with both free play and organized games.

Themed Units allow children to explore their world with books, songs, food, art projects and hand's on activities.
